# Feather \& Fan Crochet Stitch Pattern 

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US CROCHET TERMINOLOGY



## Tools \& Materials

Suggested yarn thicknesses and corresponding hook sizes:
4ply/Fingering weight yarn $-3.5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{E}$.
DK/Sport weight yarn - 4mm/G.
Worsted/Aran weight yarn - $5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{H}$.

I have used a 4 ply yarn with a $3.5 \mathrm{~mm} / E$ hook

## Key

beg - beginning
ch - chain
dc - double crochet
sk - skip
sl st - slip st
st(s) - stitch(es)

Supplies

Multicoloured yarn: 4ply Superfine Merino by WitchCraftyLady on Etsy.
Green yarn: Cotton Merino by Mayflower on Ritohobby.co.uk

## Instructions

This is a 19 stitch pattern repeat. If you want to make something wider, such as a blanket or scarf, chain extra multiples of 19 . I would recommend crocheting this swatch first to familiarise yourself with the stitch. Wash and block the swatch so that you have an accurate idea of your gauge.

## Chain 57

Row 1 : make an additional ch3 (counts as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ); work this row into the back ridge of the chain as follows - make 2 dc in $4^{\text {th }}$ ch from hook; 3 dc into the next ch; *(sk1 ch, 1dc in the next ch) 7 times; sk1 ch; (in the next ch make 3dc) 4 times*; repeat from *to* twice; sk1 ch, 1 dc in the next ch) 7 times; sk1 ch; in the next ch make 3dc; in the last ch make 3dc.
Row 2 : ch3 (counts as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ), 2dc in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{st}$; 3 dc into the next st ; * (sk1 st, 1dc in the next st) 7 times; sk1 st; (in the next st make 3 dc ) 4 times*; repeat from *to* twice; sk1 st, 1dc in the next st) 7 times; sk1 st; in the next st make 3dc; make 3dc in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of beg ch3.

Repeat Row 2 as many times as desired.
