

## Scrap Sock Yarn Hair Scrunchie

*Quick, fun & easy, these hair-band covers are a great way to use up & showcase your precious scraps of hand-dyed yarn.*

### Overview

- ❖ Written in US crochet terminology
- ❖ Materials - 4ply Yarn, 4g / 15m / 16yds for each hairband
- ❖ Hook – 2.5mm / C/2
- ❖ Thick hairband, approx. 5cm in diameter

## Materials & Tools

4ply Yarn, 4g / 15m / 16yds for each hairband.

Hook – 2.5mm / C/2.

Thick hairband, approx. 5cm in diameter, in a similar colour to yarn.

Tapestry or wool needle.

### Notes:

I have used Little Bird Sock, hand-dyed yarn which is 80% Superwash Merino, 20% Nylon in the colourway “Let’s Get This Party Started” by Lottie Knits ([www.lottieknits.com](http://www.lottieknits.com))

## Key

ch – chain

dc – double crochet

sc – single crochet

sl st – slip stitch

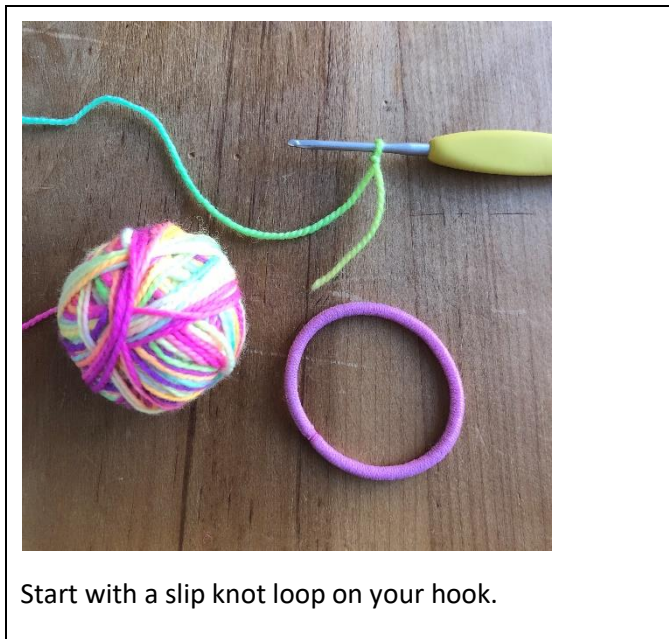
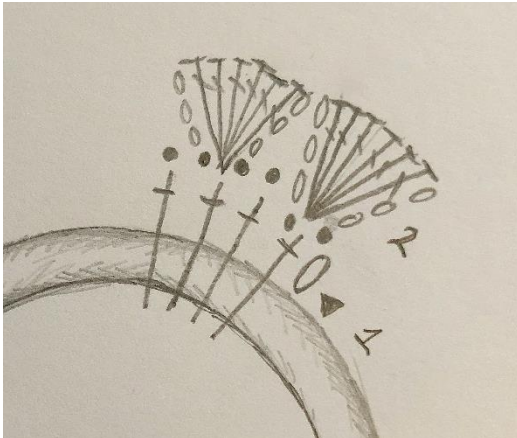
sp – space

st(s) - stitch(es)

## Scrap Sock Yarn Hair Band

### Instructions with Photos (Instructions without photos at end)

#### Chart



Start with a slip knot loop on your hook.

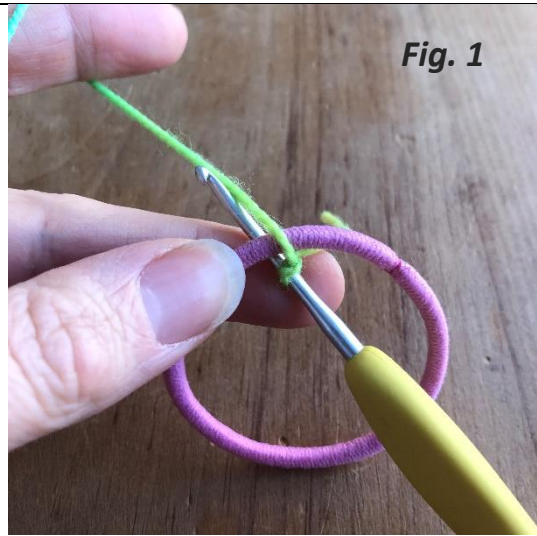

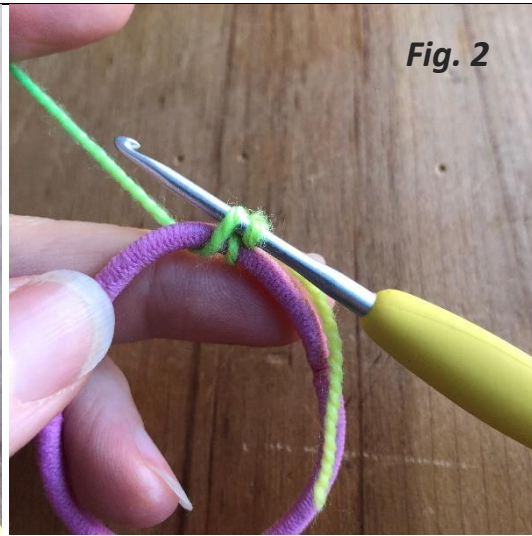

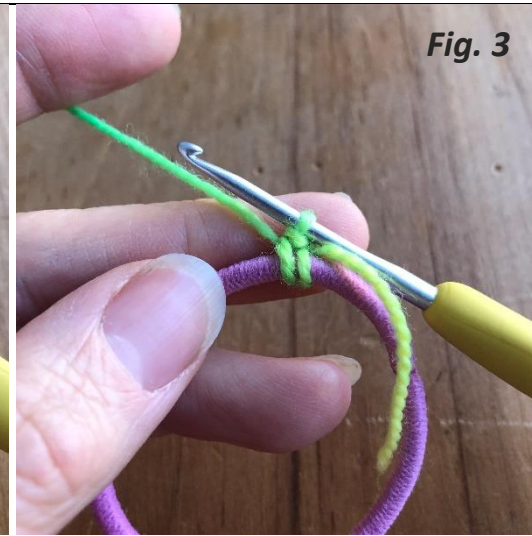

**Row 1** : Insert hook through the centre of the band (*fig. 1*) and pull up a loop from the back (*fig. 2*), ch1 (*fig. 3*)



**Row 1 continued ...**: sc crochet *around* the band, 38-40 times - taking care not to stack the stitches too close to each other or to have too much space between each; join round with sl st in 1st st of round.



**Row 2** : ch3, 6dc in the same sp, ch3, sl st in same sp...



**Row 2 continued ...** : sl st in next st...



**Row 2 continued ...** : in next st – sl st, ch3, 6dc, ch3, sl st; (sl st in next st; in next st – sl st, ch3, 6dc, ch3, sl st in same sp) all the way around...



**Row 2 continued ...** : sl st in base of 1st petal, fasten off and weave end into stitch cluster of petal.



Sew in and trim starting tail.

### Instructions (No Photos)

Start with a slip knot loop on your hook.

**Row 1** : Insert hook through the centre of the band and pull up a loop from the back, ch1; sc crochet *around* the band, 38-40 times - taking care not to stack the stitches too close to each other or to have too much space between each; join round with sl st in 1st st of round.

**Row 2** : ch3, 6dc in the same sp, ch3, sl st in same sp; (sl st in next st; in next st – sl st, ch3, 6dc, ch3, sl st) all around; join round with sl st in base of 1st petal, fasten off and weave end into stitch cluster of petal.

Sew in and trim starting tail.
